 - a. Principal's Report: Ms. Welch shared that admin is in budget and planning for the rest of this year and next year. Course selection is currently being developed, TUSD has seen a reduction in enrollment which leads to a loss of funding. We are in good shape staff wise, if cutting is necessary, we can cut 6/5 positions. Testing is in April – ACT Inspire, practice, AZ Science, CTE to name a few. Advanced Placements are also not far off. The North Gym's renovations are now complete. Some classes are going to be able to return, some will wait due to the restrooms being renovated. No date yet for the Auditorium. The workers are wrapping the support beams, perhaps another month, stay tuned for another update. Bond monies may not be available for another year. Other facilities included are the new buzzer to enter the building, "Closed Campus" is nearly finalized. Gates in front of the T-Bldg. are on their way, once they are put in, the school will be more secure. Future Freshman Family Night took place and seemed successful, approximately 70-100 students and their family members attended with the staff.

 - c. PTA: A lot of events are coming up, March 20th there is a Skate Country Night (5-7 pm?) to raise funds for the seniors and for Teacher Appreciation (snack cart). Maybe Student Council could assist with this, maybe do after testing – date to be determined. March 23rd is Campus Clean-up, volunteer hours for students. This will be from 9-11:30 and pizza afterward for the volunteers. Senior Fun Day is May 21st following the graduation practice.
