- II. December minutes were approved, no nays.
- III. Call to the Audience: None
- IV. Reports:
  - a. <u>Principal's Report:</u> Ms. Welch shared that they are working on course selection, job fairs are coming up but there may be some cuts (may need to cut the 6/5 staff) and budgets are being reviewed before the job fair. District wide Title 1 cuts across the board which may affect Rincon. TUVA hasn't been receiving and that will be fixed. The gym and auditorium are being worked on and possibly the north gym will be done by the end of Spring Break (auditorium does not have a set completion date yet). The restrooms by the Little Theater will be finished by this weekend and hopefully next week will be ready to be used. All bathrooms should be completed by the end of the year. The bathrooms in the T-Building should be finished by next week. Spring Sports has begun this week, turn out looks good with lots of participation. A new grounds keeper was hired, and a new engineer will also be hired to support our current one. New Student Night is February 29<sup>th</sup> (Thursday) from 5:30-7:00 pm and will be held in the cafeteria. We also have a new auto teacher, and he will take over in the next two weeks. Our School Counselors are being celebrated and a cake will be shared later.
  - b. <u>Finance Report:</u> The current balance is \$9,100.43.
  - c. <u>PTA</u>: There will be a booth on the New Student Night to have a sign-up option. There is a plan for another Senior Fun Day (looking for new name) and there is also an Amazon list that people can donate by purchasing things. Senior breakfast then a raffle will happen. Afterwards there will be other activities for them to participate in after the graduation rehearsal. There is a tentative Campus Clean-up, and the date will be determined at tonight's meeting.

- d. <u>Rincon Ranger Foundation</u>: Ms. Grijalva shares the kickoff with 4 \$1500 scholarships, a McAvoy Scholarship for \$1500, and Grijalva Scholarship for \$1500 scholarships for the Spring for a total of 6 scholarships, applications are ready now. The money is given to the bursar at the university, not directly to the awarded student. A golf fundraiser will happen at the end of May to support the scholarship funding.
- e. <u>Rincon Education Foundation</u>: Ms. Grijalva shares that the last \$100.00 grant will be released in May. There has been good feedback on the use of that money.
- f. <u>Student Council Report:</u> Mr. McDonough shares that Valentine Grams, and the Blood Drive will be on buses on February 14<sup>th</sup>. Trying to work with UHS on 2 things, towards the middle of April and early May, a combined campus early sunset for seniors. Student Council also wants to do another Spring Spirit Assembly, date to be determined later.
