



FAFSA VERIFICATION

What You Should Know



WHAT IS VERIFICATION?

Verification is the process of a college confirming that the information provided on the FAFSA is accurate. It also allows the school to confirm a student's eligibility for grants, loans, and work-study.

HOW DO I KNOW IF I'VE BEEN SELECTED FOR VERIFICATION?

Check your college's student portal or contact your college's financial aid office.



WHEN DO I COMPLETE VERIFICATION?

Verification should be completed as soon as possible. Failure to complete verification in a timely manner can impact your financial aid eligibility. Verification must be completed prior to receiving any financial aid.

WHAT DO I SUBMIT FOR VERIFICATION?



Students and parents are asked for tax documents, head of household documentation, proof of citizenship, or proof of residency. You may be able to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to submit tax information.
