- III. Call to the Audience: No audience members presented
- IV. Reports:
 - a. Principal's Report: End of semester is approaching, feedback for teachers is happening - students taking surveys, benchmark exams are coming up, our school letter grade has dropped to a C and it is probably due to graduation rates for 2022 falling. Partially dropped due to COVID and online learning made for difficulty for many students. Graduation may also be affected due to having only 6 periods where our other sister schools had more periods to offer. Our English Language Learners did well (8 out of 10), two bonus points for our Exceptional Education programs - had great progress. Open enrollment status has also affected us, if a student has a severe credit deficiency and wants to attend Rincon, it affects us negatively because our district wants families to be able to choose where their child goes. A change in safety protocols has been initiated because of an incident that happened where a student who just graduated came on campus without permission. Administration is working with security (monitors) and TPD to maintain safety on our campus.
 - b. Finance Report: This month's fiscal amount is, \$8313. 40.
 - c. PTA: PTA held a skate country night, made \$272.31, also planning to do a Ranger Family dinner night once a month. Will have a flyer set-up to let families know to let all know where this is going to be held. Want to also have a campus clean up in conjunction with UHS, next meeting Monday Nov 14th at 6 pm in library and on Zoom. PTA is also supporting the Student of the Quarter program as well.
 - d. Ranger Foundation: Last Saturday had the Hall of Fame breakfast and inducted Brenda Kazen and other people. 128 people attended and all had a great time. Next thing that will happen will be the golf tournament next June.

e. Student Council Report: Made \$200 for the candy Halloween grams, Winter Formal is Dec. 17 at the Ambassador event center from 7-11 pm. Ticket sales are being discussed; information will come out later.

V. Action items:

Coach Copeland – request for football \$14,700.00 for top and bottom uniforms from Riddell. Buy one set 50 tops and 50 bottoms as Riddell has offered to provide the other 50 needed uniforms. This is to be in compliance with AIA to have 3 jerseys for the team to be a 3-team program. Looking for consistency in the program. The offer from Riddell ends Dec. 16th provided half the money needed is turned in as a down payment. Had other fundraisers as well to help and has made \$90.90. Does plan to meet with UHS Site Council to request monies. Will talk with Ms. Wheeler and Mr. Lovegren for financial support.

Baseball – Coach Romero and Coach Ozzie are requesting money to replenish jersey tops and will split the amount with the baseball club and booster and is requesting \$2475.00. They plan to ask UHS Site Council for another item (pitching machine).

Ms. Grijalva moves to give \$2000 to football and \$1000 to baseball. Ms. Damiani seconds this motion. This motion passes unanimously, no nays.
