- I. The meeting called to order at 3:32 pm.

- IV. Reports:
 - a. Principal's Report: Mr. Madrid shared that construction will take place over Fall Break to include changing Room 223 into 2 classrooms. The library will also begin with a remodeling. The security cameras will also begin to be installed soon, the materials for the wiring will be delivered tomorrow. They will work at night while school is in session then during day in Fall Break. New concrete on the southwest corner of the south gym will be replaced on outside (pavement). The flooring in the kitchen of the cafeteria will also be replaced, date will be determined when that can happen. Ms. Welch shared that we are wrapping up the first quarter, mid-term progress to show students and families where they are at. Still time to turn things around before semester ends. Examining enrollment, down about 100 students (around 1313). We are considered a "green light" school meaning we accept any student wanting to attend. We have no spare space if we have an issue like broken air conditioning. Ms. Welch was able to discuss with 1010 the issues related to this with the hope that we will be switched to a "red light" school (meaning not taking any more students). We will lose one math teacher, otherwise we are fully staffed.
 - b. Finance Report: No information available currently. This month's fiscal amount is, \$11,497. 22.
